## BUSINESS PLAN GUIDELINES / RULES

- All business plans must be submitted on or before February 19th,2019 morning, on either of the following email addresses: teena.wadhera@jimsindia.org silky@jimsindia.org
- Teams not meeting this deadlines will be disqualified.
- Team members restricted to 2-4 members each team.
- The business plan should be as per the format mentioned in the next page.
- Business plan will be distributed to the judges.
- Pre-screening of business plan will take place before the event & only 10 entries will be shortlisted for round 1.
- Plan should include company summary, product/ service description, marketing strategy and the financial plan.
- Detailed spreadsheets and appropriate appendices may follow the test portion of the plan. But will be limited to 10 pages. In total, the plan should be no longer than 50 pages.
- Judgement will take place in 2 rounds:

**Round 1-** (Valued at 40%) is designed to help assess the return business plan focusing on key elements like business idea, PowerPoint presentation, communication skills, body language.

**Round 2-** (60%) assesses the poise and professionalism of presentations & also evaluates the perceived viability of the venture.

In the final round, each team will be given 15 minutes to present its business plan followed by a **10 minute question and answer session**. Each member of the team must participate in the formal presentation of the plan.

• 3 best teams will be awarded.

- Company identifies an unfilled need.
- Company's strategy satisfies this needs.
- Company has identified and allocated resources to be successful.
- Company utilizes resources effectively.
- Company has a realistic and strong competitive advantage.
- Company has a thorough target market analysis.
- Revenue and profit models that are reasonable and appropriate.
- Realistic time frame for company growth.

- Time allotted to each participant will be 4 mins + 1 min.
- Mode of language: only English.
- 3 best teams and 1 best speaker will be awarded.



### DOUBLE KA DHAMAKA

- 1 team allowed from each Institute/College.
- Each team may comprise of two boys / two girls or one boy & one girl.
- Theme: Bollywood
- Participants are required to carry CD's / PD.
- Time limit- 4 mins.
- 3 best teams will be awarded.



### **MAIN BHI ACTOR HOON**

- Individual participation.
- Participants have to inact a scene.
- Language can be English or Hindi.
- Time limit will be 3 mins.
- Judgement will be done on the basis of
  - Expression
  - Voice control
  - Action
  - Emotional involvement
- 3 best actors will be awarded.



### INTER COLLEGE FILM FESTIVAL

- Only 1 entry of 5 members will be allowed from each Institute/ College in each of the following categories:
  - Documentary (10-15 mins.)
  - Fiction (10 mins.)
  - Quickies (20 sec.-2 mins)
- Theme: Social Issue
- The film can be coloured or black and white.
- The film should be submitted in DVD either as data file or as DVD video file by February 19th, 2019.
- Film should have been produced, directed & edited by student only.
- Title of the film, name of the producer/director & year of production should be mentioned on a DVD all in the forwarding letter
- 2 best films will be awarded in each category.





- Only 1 team per college. Each team will have 2 participants
- All teams are required to carry their own set of kitchen tools kits (knives, peelers, spoons, etc.) and crockery for display.
- Participating teams have to prepare a given menu for which all raw material will be provided by organizers. No additional material will be given to the teams on demand.
- Use of ingredients other than those issued will lead to disqualification.
- The team will prepare a 3 course menu given to them on the spot
- All participants must ensure that they reach the venue at least 30 minutes prior to the time of commencement of the competition.
- Recipe writing has to be done within the stipulated time period. Presentation of recipe is a must at the time of dish presentation.
- All the participants must leave their working area clean after the preparation is over.
- Winners will be decided on the basis of taste, texture & presentation of food and minimum wastage
- The decision of the judges will be final and no queries in this regard will be entertained.
- 3 best teams will be awarded



### **TALENT UNLIMITED**

- A team (1-10 members) allowed from each Institute/ College.
- Time limit maximum of 2 mins.
- Participants have to bring their own material for the performance.
- Participants have to bring their own CDs and PD.
- No act involving display of fire will be allowed.
- 3 best teams will be awarded.

### RANG MANCH STREET PLAY

- 1 team allowed from each Institute / College
- Maximum 15 to 20 members.
- Time limit 10 mins.
- Script and choreography is to be done by the participants.
- No mikes will be provided.
- "Theme" Social Media Fun or Stress
- 3 best teams will be awarded.



## LET'S ROCK THE ROCK BAND COMPETITION

- Time limit 20 minutes (10 minutes for stage setup and 10 minutes for performance)
- Theme Hindi /Sufi /English rock
- 2 best teams and 1 best performer will be awarded.



### DRESS A CAKE

- Only 1 team per Institute. Each team will have 2 participants.
- All participants are required to bring their own tools and small equipments such as turntables, palette knife, base, cake knife, etc.
- The organisers will be providing work table, sponges, material for icing.
- Any decoration material, such as colours, moulds, sprinklers, piping bags, nozzles etc will not be provided.
- All the participants must leave their working area clean after the preparation is over.
- 3 best teams will be awarded.





# MIXOLOGY INNOVATIVE BARTENDING

- Maximum 2 participants are allowed from each Institute.
- Time duration will be 30 minutes
- Bar will be setup with all ingredients. (Participants are required to bring their own glassware and accessories)
- Participants will be judged on the basis of their innovative skills, taste and presentation.
- 3 best participants will be awarded.



### **CHILL PHOTOGRAPHY**

- Each individual can give 1 Entry on any of the category below-

- Photograph should be 8" X 10" size on either Glossy or Matte Finish
